

Pre Professional Program

Students accepted into the Pre Professional Program must take a minimum of 5 ballet classes per week as well as repertoire classes. Students must also be available for evening and weekend rehearsals. This program is for dancers who wish to pursue a professional career in dance or a college dance major.

Tuition Policy

- ✚ Tuition is based on a yearly fee and is divided into 10 payments
- ✚ **Payments are due at the beginning of each month. A late fee will be added after 30 days.** No refunds will be given. We do not send out bills. Please keep accounts up to date. If you elect to make semi-annual payments, the first payment will be due on September 10th and the second payment will be due February 10th.
- ✚ All missed classes must be paid for and a make-up class may be taken.
- ✚ Snow days must also be paid for and make-up classes will be scheduled.
- ✚ Make-up classes are available for any absence. It is the responsibility of the student/parent to take advantage of attending them. The school will not refund tuition to students who elect not to make up a class.
- ✚ Make-up classes may be taken at the same level of lower level classes.
- ✚ All students dropping from or changing a program must call and give an exit date or you will be billed for the year. If your child will be out for a month or several weeks the school needs to be informed prior to the departure date in order to withhold tuition. If the school is not informed you will be responsible for payment.
- ✚ If you elect to pay per class rather than by our tuition schedule, students need to purchase a pre-paid class card. There are no discounts given for class cards. Class cards are purchased in 10 class increments. The card must be presented at the desk and stamped before each class begins.

Code of Conduct

All Ballet Classes

Attire:

Basic Black Leotard- Long sleeve, short sleeve, or camisole (No crisscross straps)

****Level E an Pre Professional Program-** Solid, dark color, basic leotard (Long or short sleeve or camisole. NO crisscross straps, rhinestones, etc.)

Pink Tights

Pink Ballet Slippers- Split-sole, canvas (Preferred)

***No skirts, pants, leg warmers, t-shirts, or shorts allowed during class

Short Black Skirts may be worn with the teacher's permission on a limited basis

***In the winter season a black fitted **dance** sweater may be worn (No sweatshirts and no hoods allowed)

No excessive jewelry is to be worn (Absolutely no necklaces, bracelets, or watches)

Saturday Classes- Optional leotard color choice

Hair:

Neat Buns- Hair must be worn in a neat bun (hair net preferred) No messy buns, ponytails, etc.

Strict adherence to this dress code is mandatory. If the dress code is not followed, students may be asked to leave class or may not be granted permission to participate.

Classroom Etiquette:

Please arrive to class **15 minutes** early. This will give you time to stretch, warm-up, and be ready to start class on time.

Have all water bottles and pointe shoes in the studio where you are taking class before the class begins. Be sure to remove them after class.

***If you arrive late to class you must be given permission by the teacher to participate.

***If for any reason you need to leave during class, you must ask permission of the instructor.

As a member of the Woodbury Ballet, you represent the result of the intensive training offered from our concentrated programs. You must display professional behavior at all times, whether attending classes, rehearsals or performances. You are participating in a professional training program.

It is mandatory that all dress code and etiquette procedures are followed.

The Woodbury Ballet must always present itself as a professional company. We are expecting that you will follow these guidelines. If on more than two occasions, these guidelines are not met, we will meet with you and your parents to discuss your continued participation in this program.

General Information

ATTIRE/RULES

- Hair should be worn in a bun.
- Pink tights and pink ballet slippers (canvas recommended) must be worn for ballet.
- The school leotard color is **black**.
- Black tap shoes.
- No skirts, leg warmers, or tee shirts allowed in Ballet class.
- Boys: white tee shirt (no oversized shirts), black tights or fitted black Jazz pants (during summer months fitted black shorts are allowed), white socks (no athletic socks), white or black ballet slippers, black tap shoes.
- No excessive jewelry should be worn in class.
- No talking in class.
- Absolutely no chewing gum in class.
- Food or drinks with the exception of a water bottle are not allowed in the studio.
- Parents are allowed to observe class once a month.

Please adhere to dress code and hair regulations.
